

D. Lgs. 196/2003 – Note about protection of personal data

Alhambra s.r.l. informs you that we take care of the protection and handling of personal data according to D.Lgs No. 196, June 30, 2003 (Italian Legislative Decree) entitled “Codice in materia di protezione dei dati personali” (Code about personal data safeguard). Under that legislation, the handling of your personal data will be based on principles of fairness, lawfulness and transparency and having care of the protection of your privacy. According to Article. 13 of Legislative Decree No 196 of June 30, 2003, we provide the following information:

1. Scope and methods of data processing

Your personal data have been provided and will be used exclusively for purposes strictly connected and instrumental to the implementation of tax and accounting obligations and obligations relating to the supply agreement, in particular:

- for inclusion in our personal data base;
- to manage accounts;
- to manage receipts and payments;
- to fulfill the obligations required by the rules of civil and tax laws, regulations, EC legislation.

The processing of personal data will be carried out by paper and with the help of modern computer systems; the managers and the employees will ensure measures that guarantee security and privacy

2. Nature of data collection

Providing your personal information is required in order to fulfill the obligations arising from legal obligations and, in general, by the agreement.

3. Communication and dissemination of data

Your personal data to fulfill the contract and for the purposes outlined above, may be disclosed:

- to legal offices, administrative, tax, companies' auditors, shippers and couriers, the data processing center, etc.. where the communication is necessary for the purposes outlined above;
- to banks for the management of receipts and payments;
- to factoring companies or debt collection;
- our staff and employees within their duties;
- any further communication and dissemination will be subject to your express consent.

4. Right to access Personal Data and Other Rights

According to article 7 of Legislative Decree 196, June 30, 2003 you have the following rights towards the data controller:

1. right to obtain confirmation whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
2. right to be informed about
 - a) the source of the personal data;
 - b) the purposes and methods of the processing;
 - c) the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
 - d) the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5 (2);
 - e) the institutions or categories of institutions to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.
3. right to obtain
 - a) updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
 - b) erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that have been unlawfully processed, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
 - c) certification to the effect that the operations a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the institutions to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.
4. right to object, in whole or in part,
 - a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
 - b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.
